Chile

Chile has one of the most advanced economies in South America and its strength lies in its stability. Chile is consistently the highest-ranked country in Latin America in terms of economic competitiveness and also has relatively low levels of poverty.

Chile is a strong trading partner and export market for U.S. companies, largely due to its open market policies, zero tariffs, democratic government, solid business practices, and low corruption. Virginia exports to Chile were valued at \$64M in 2023.

Chileans generally view U.S. products and services to be high quality and innovative. Some of the best opportunities for U.S. companies are in high-value projects requiring innovative solutions, such as 5G technology and applications, data analytics, public transportation platforms, and smart grid technologies.

Peru

Peru has one of the fastest-growing economies in Latin America. It is well integrated in the global economy through its multiple free trade agreements, including the U.S.-Peru Trade Promotion Agreement. Its prudent macroeconomic and fiscal

policies, openness to trade, and growing middle class make Peru one of the best places to do business in South America.

Peru's economy is dependent upon its natural resources, such as minerals and fish. The country's manufacturing and services sectors are relatively small but growing. Light manufacturing remains Peru's largest industry sector, and its tourism industry continues to see rapid growth. Virginia's exports to Peru were valued at \$76M in 2023.
