Saudi Arabia

Saudi Arabia is the largest country in the Gulf region with a population of 36 million, and the largest economy in the Arab world with a GDP of \$83B. Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 and the National Transformation Program (NTP) suggest a paradigm shift from a public sector-driven economy to one where job creation and economic growth are driven by the private sector. The NTP outlines \$4 billion in ICT initiatives over the next five years and \$1.5 billion in transportation initiatives over the next four years. In addition, Saudi Arabia was recently awarded the right to host the 2034 FIFA World Cup, one of the world's largest sporting events.

Known for its advanced transportation infrastructure, the UAE is a recognized trade hub with 75% of the world being reachable within an eight-hour
